•Please use the screws carefully. Types of Screws used are shown below.










Note: The Swash holder is installed opposite to the stock version of the King.






## FIBER FRAME for King II




Note: •Make sure the belt guide can be freely rotate after securing the screws.
•You may choose to install the stock King II belt guide in the other 2 holes.








Note: •Install the parts as shown in the diagram. NOT all holes need screws at this stage. •Install Servo at this stage will be easier










### Step 6

Note: The position of the 6 inter-frame supports are shown in the diagram. Note that 2 of them are longer in length.







Note: •Secure the Upper frame and Lower frame. Make sure the belt guide. •The ring included is to be place between the belt gear and the frame.
